### 1. Attenzione a questo errore:

Con **HE SHE IT** nella forma **NEGATIVA** si mette **DOESN'T**

**Ma** il verbo dopo la forma base non ha più la **S**.

EX. (esempio)

He **doesn't** play tennis. (lui non gioca a tennis. **Play senza la S** )

### 2. Secondo errore:

**...your dog** like hamburgers? Yes, he **does**. (frase pag. 41 new grammar)

**Your dog** è il pronome **IT**, quindi, useremo **DOES** per fare la domanda.

DOES your dog like hamburgers?

### 3. Terzo errore:

Quando ci sono due nomi vicini (Zoe and Justin- frase 4 pag. 41), sicuramente è il pronome **THEY**. Quindi, useremo **DO**.

EX. **DO** Zoe and Justin watch tv?
